



### **Fantesca's 2005 Cabernet Sauvignon**

The grapes for this wine were harvested from Fantesca Estate on Spring Mountain in 2005. Fantesca's vineyard is located on the southeastern side of Spring Mountain, with tremendous variations in slope just under 10 acres of vines. The elevation and mountain terrain offer superb sun exposure and a long growing season.

The Fantesca character and this property share a long legacy of dynamic women. The vineyard was originally part of Caroline Bale's dowry when she married Charles Krug in 1860. Even then, it was recognized as prime mountain vineyard land. 31 years before women had the right to vote, The Krugs had a female winemaker named Hannah Weinberger. A wine she produced from this vineyard won one of the first awards for a wine from the Napa Valley in 1889.

The unique terroir here produces a rich and intense Cabernet, true to the character of the Spring Mountain District.

The nose of this wine contains notes of black cherry and molasses. There are lively hints of rosemary and crushed herbs. As you take the wine in your mouth, you taste cherry, cedar, and lively acids. The wine finishes with beautiful, dusty tannins that will become more and more elegant as this mountain Cabernet ages.
