2006 King Richard's Pinot Noir Reserve

Sourced from the Baccigalupi Vineyard in the famed Pinot lands of the Russian River Valley, this ruby red shows the smooth, rich and ripe varietal traits. The typical cool climate characters of fresh raspberry, cherry, cranberry, spice box mingle with gentle barrel vanillin to concoct the wine's heady aromas. The deeply layered palate has a natural, non aggressive warmth that is full of ripe and seductive red berry jams, tart cherry and a mild espresso. The acidity yields to the coating tannin in the mid and back palate flavors. This small, 60 case production was whole berry destemmed and fermented in a small open top tank and French oak cask for complexity and aged sur lie for 14 months in 50% new French Oak. Enjoy now until 2015 or longer.
