2004 Fantesca Estate Petit Verdot

Fantesca's 2004 Petit Verdot

This is an eclectic wine that should be in every collector's cellar. Petit Verdot can be a challenging, difficult to tame varietal at times, used primarily for blending however this rendition finds balance of acid and tannin with plenty of complexity. The 2004 Fantesca is rare example of this powerful Bordeaux varietal. The color is beautiful with a deep black and blue hue. The nose is full of overripe plum, barrel vanillin, black fruit with a background of chocolate dipped espresso bean that is so indicative of the Spring Mountain vineyard site. The palate has seamless texture, full of black cherry with a wonderful, juicy and bright midpalate. The tannins are balanced and do a fine job of supporting the fine components to wine, not overpower them. Enjoy through 2020. 100% new French oak, bottled unfiltered and unfined.
